What's been happening this week?

Nursery



In Nursery, our book of the week has been 'The Enormous Turnip'. The children loved acting out the story wearing their character headbands! They have also enjoyed painting and printing with vegetables. In Maths, we have enjoyed weighing vegetables to find out which is lighter or heavier.

This week Pearl and Topaz class have been learning coins. In Pearl class we have been recognising, ordering and comparing coins. In Topaz class the children have ordered coins and made simple amounts. In science, we have been learning about habitats and made some of our own.

This week, year 4 have been writing a narrative retell from a different character's (Baba Yaga) perspective. In Maths, we are using, writing and ordering decimals. As part of our Science learning we visited the Manchester Science and Industry Museum and learnt about alternative forms of energy and explored the different exhibits.

This week, Year 6 have been learning about the *Battle of Britain* in History. The knowledge we gained will help us write a diary entry about a night in the shelters. In Science, we completed a PowerPoint presentation explaining the story of the 'peppered moth' and how this led to Charles Darwin's discovery of natural selection. We enjoyed using our iPads to complete this activity!
