Reception



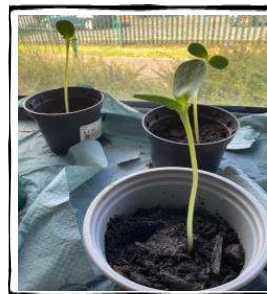

Year 3



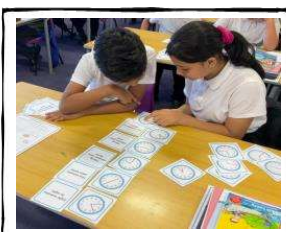
