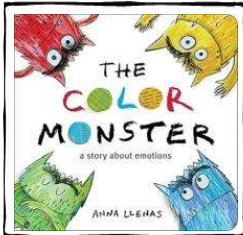
Y6 Leavers' Assembly

Reception



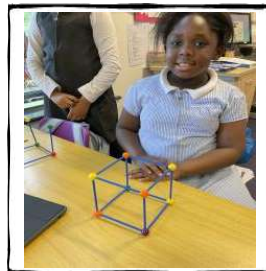
